### Minimal Waste/Sustainability Vendor Guidelines

#### Dear Vendor:

Thank you for participating in the Meet the Mountains Festival 2025! We are proud to announce that the festival is a minimal waste event. The goal at a minimal waste event is to plan ahead and distribute only materials that are recyclable or compostable so that a minimal number of materials have to be landfilled. Minimal waste events are a great way to not only show our commitment to the environment, but to create a living model of minimal waste events for the community.

As a vendor distributing free giveaways or selling products at this event, you are the key to meeting our goal: diverting at least 20% of waste produced at the festival from the landfill.

Vendors attending the Meet the Mountains Festival are strongly encouraged to hand out only recyclable or compostable materials to attendees. Please stay away from single use items such as plastic shopping bags, single-use novelties, etc.

We have included local recycling and composting guidelines with this notice so you know which types of containers and packaging will be acceptable. We've also provided you with a distributor list that you can use to purchase the correct materials. Remember, if an item is not recyclable locally, then we cannot recycle it.

### As much as possible, please refrain from using the following items:

- Single Use Novelties (plastic bags, balloons, confetti, etc.)
  - Instead, try multi-use items with functionality (paper bags, chapstick, eye-glass cleaner, carabiner, sanitizer, seed packets, reusable paper, etc.)
- Plastic-Coated Paper Products
  - Instead use wax paper
- Aluminum Foil It cannot be recycled at all.
  - Instead, use wax paper
- Styrofoam (this includes cups, plates, and boxes) It cannot be recycled at all.
  - Instead, use compostable plates or cups, and paper to-go boxes
- Plastic Straws
  - Instead use metal, hemp or paper

### Plastic Water Bottles

- Instead use canned water
- If you need to use plastic, <u>please be sure</u> that your bottles are marked with a "1" or "2" within the recycle symbol on the bottle. These bottles <u>can</u> be recycled locally. We will also have water stations set up throughout the festival.

#### Plastic Soda Bottles

- Instead use canned sodas
- If you need to use plastic, <u>please be sure</u> that your bottles are marked with a "1" or "2" within the recycle symbol on the bottle. These bottles <u>can</u> be recycled locally.

## The following items can be recycled through City of Johnson City:

- Aluminum Cans
- Plastic #1 and #2
- Cardboard
- Glass
- Paper
- Plastic Bottles

## The following items can be composted through Hoffman Composting:

- Bones
- Cooked Food
- Uncooked Food
- Cardboard
- Certified Compostable Products (this includes cups, cutlery, plates, and boxes)
- Wax-Coated Paper Products (this includes napkins, cups, plates, and boxes)
- Wax Paper
